Contact your local Public School for Kindergarten Registration
Enroll your Child for September 2018
Registration starts January 16, 201- May 31, 2018

Your child must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018



Register at your neighborhood school (to find your school, go to <https://www.philasd.org/schoolfinder>) and be sure to bring:

- Your child's up-to-date immunization records
- Parent/Legal Guardianship Identification: Current Driver's License/ Non-Driver's License, Federal, State or Municipal employment photo identification, or Passport

One of the following is required:

- Child's original birth certificate
- Copy of the record of baptism – notarized or duly certified and showing the date of birth
- Notarized statement from the parents or another relative indicating the date of birth

AND

Don't forget two current proofs of address in the parent or guardian's name. The school will ask to see two proofs of residency.

- Valid driver's license or change of address card with your current address
- Letter from Social Security Office with current address
- Letter from Public Assistance Office with current address
- Fostercare/childcare and DHS letters are acceptable for registration when a student is in the care of a foster/child care agency
- Original lease with name(s) of parents/legal guardians and children

- IRS Statement or other wage and tax statements e.g. W2, 1040, 1099
- Recent Employer Pay Stub showing current address
- Shelter placement or residency letters are acceptable for homeless students
- Signed property sales agreement, followed by original copy of settlement papers within 45 calendar days of settlement

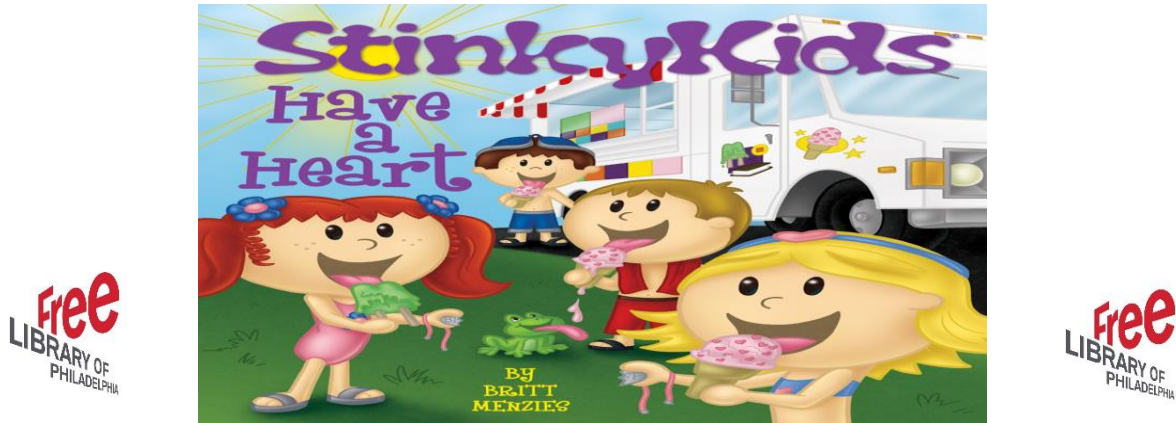

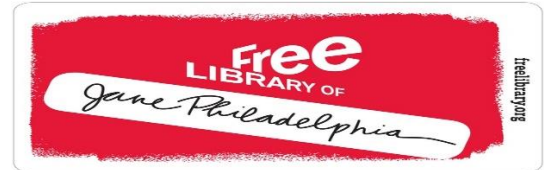

Cheesecake Cookies

Ingredients:

- Cooking spray, for pan
 - 1/2 c. cinnamon sugar
 - 1/4 c. sugar
 - pinch of salt
 - 1 16.5-oz. tube sugar cookie dough
 - 6 oz. cream cheese, softened
 - 1/2 tsp. vanilla
 - 6 oz. cool whip
-

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350° and grease two 12-cup muffin with cooking spray. Slice the cookie dough into 20 portions, then press each disc of dough into a muffin cup, patting the sides down gently to form a well.
2. Sprinkle with cinnamon-sugar and bake for 10 to 12 minutes, or until the cookies are lightly golden.
3. As soon as they're out, use a shot glass (sprayed with cooking spray) to gently press down the center of each cookie. Set tray aside to cool for at least 20 minutes. Remove from baking tray to cool completely on wire rack.
4. Meanwhile, make cheesecake filling. In a large bowl using a hand mixer, beat cream cheese, sugar, vanilla and salt until smooth. Gently fold in Cool Whip.
5. Spoon filling into cooled cookie cups, smoothing the top with an offset spatula and serve.

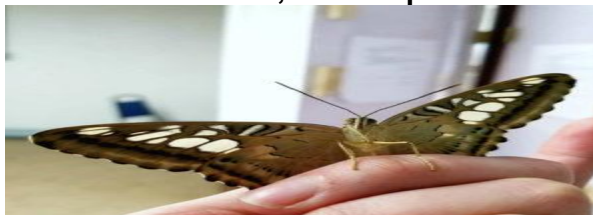
