Follow your escape plan. Feel a door before you open it. Stay low to the floor. Call 9-1-1 or the fire department.

And Remember...<u>Stop, Drop, and Roll</u>. If your clothing catches fire, remember to stop where you are and drop to the ground. Cover your face and mouth with your hands, and roll over and over until the flames are out.



The simplest definition of A STRANGER is "someone you do not know." Children need to know this definition, but they also need to know about "safe" strangers. Safe strangers are teachers, police officers, firefighters and other adults who work with children. They might know these people only by sight, not personally. Emphasize the importance of seeking help from these safe strangers in public places. It's never a good idea to enter the home of a stranger alone. Stay more than an arm's reach from strangers. If you are approached by a stranger, seek help immediately. If you feel you are being followed or something is not right, seek help immediately. Use the buddy system, avoid walking anywhere alone.

Low Cost Trip Idea #1-Plan A Family Day Trip to the Fire Station



The local firehouse is filled with heroes that children enjoy meeting, and a visit may be the highlight of your child's week. Most fire departments enjoy showing off their equipment and the firefighters enjoy the fact that the admiring children will be awed by the equipment that they use in their daily job of keeping the community safe. Call your local fire station to see if visits are possible and try to arrange a tour of the facility as your next family day trip. Drop in visits are usually not encouraged.

A successful day trip to the local fire department is a fun learning activity as the child can't help coming away without a better understanding of fire safety.
