SWIMMING SAFETY TIPS



TRY THE YMCA FOR FAMILY SWIMMING LESSONS!!!

So it is really hot and you decide to take a dip in the pool. But before you have fun out in the sun, here are 10 precautions to take.

1. **Don't eat or drink near the pool.** This can pose a safety hazard. Plus, the food might cause you to choke.
2. **See how deep the water is.** If you can't swim, it's best to stay in the shallow water until you get better at swimming.
3. **Don't run!** You can slip and fall on water, which not only will cause serious injuries, but could also cause you to slip into the water, and drown.
4. **Have an adult watch you who knows how to swim.** Just in case something happens. If that isn't possible, make sure there is a lifeguard.
5. **Make sure someone at the pool knows [CPR](#) just in case someone drowns.**
6. **If you go on the diving board, make sure not to slip or dive if you don't know how.** Also, don't dive in the shallow end, you could hurt your head.
7. **Make sure not to push people into the water, even in good fun.** They might not know how to swim and drown.
8. **Don't use electronic devices near the pool, or you might electrocute yourself.**
9. **Don't swim in a very cold pool (try to test the water), or you could shock yourself.**
10. **Make sure to have a life jacket if you are just learning to swim.**

1. **Washing Hair Regularly**. Washing their hair with shampoo may be necessary at least every other day.



2. **Bathing**

Young children either love the bath or hate it. On non-shampoo days, you can make a thorough bath into a fun game. Have your child put on their bathing suit and place them into the tub with a washcloth, a bowl of warm, soapy water, and a bowl of warm water for rinsing. Make sure they know to put the washcloth into the soapy water before scrubbing a body part and then into the rinse water before repeating.



3. **Brushing Teeth** Clean teeth and gums can prevent a wide range of health issues, including bad breath, cavities, and heart disease later in life. Your child should brush and floss at least twice per day, if not after every meal.



4. **Hand-washing** Hand-washing is an integral piece of good hygiene. Washing before and after meals, after playing in the dirt or with pets, and after being in contact with someone who's sick is the best way to eliminate germs. Hand sanitizers aren't as effective as soap and water, so use them only in a pinch.

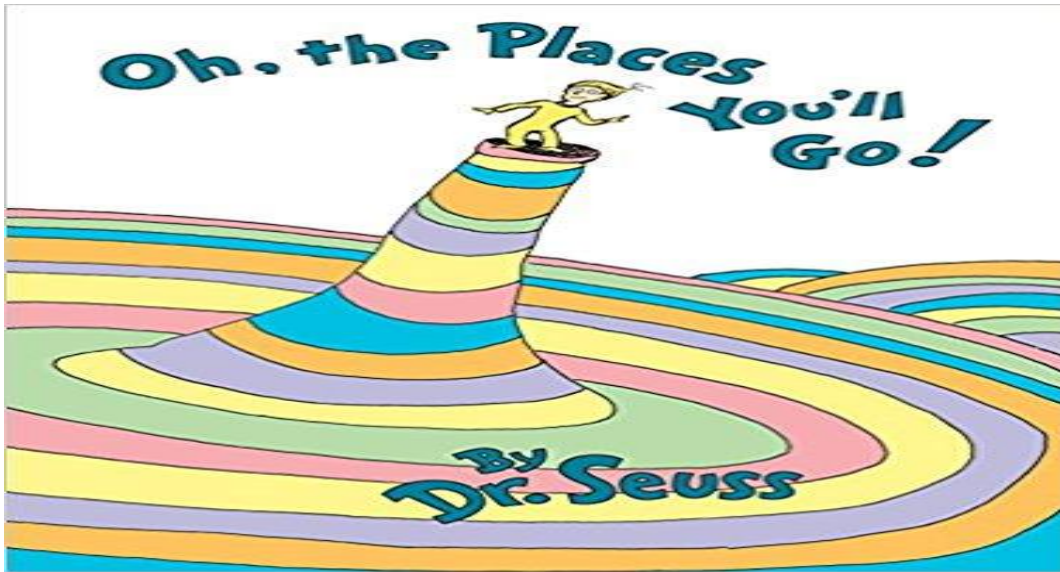

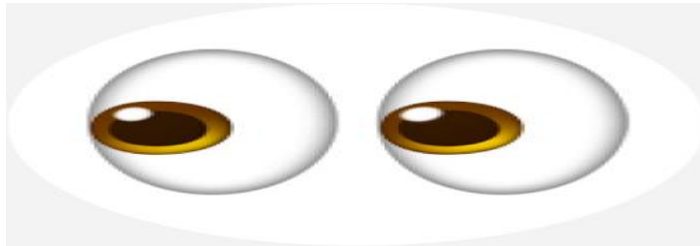
